WHAT IS THE ROCKY MOUNTAIN COLLEGIATE CYBER DEFENSE COMPETITION

The RMCCDC is a well established competition that provides collegiate teams an opportunity to test their cybersecurity knowledge and abilities.

The competition provides faculty with a measure of the strength of their curriculum, students will find out how they do against long odds and intense pressure, while employers can search for future security, network and systems engineers. 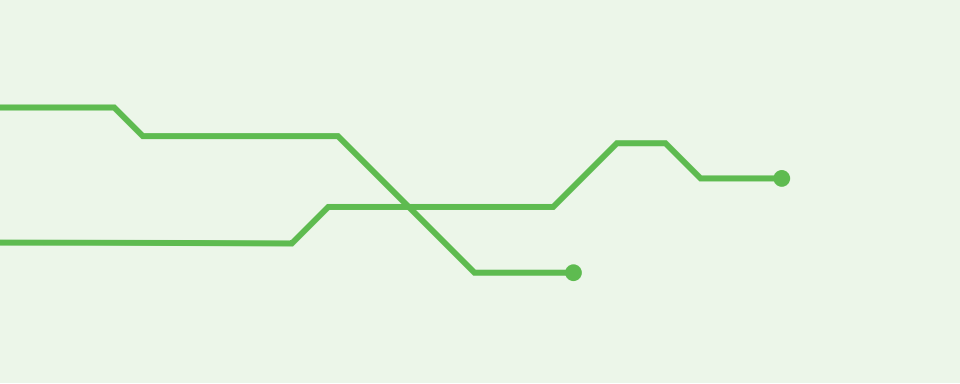
