

## Military Scholars Fund Application

### SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

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1. **AWARDS MAY BE MADE IN ANY AMOUNT UP TO \$1,000 PER AWARD, WITH NO MORE THAN ONE ALLOWABLE AWARD PER STUDENT, PER ACADEMIC YEAR.** Military veterans and dependent children/spouses of military veterans. In any academic year, the amount awarded to (a) veteran students shall exceed the amount awarded to (b) eligible dependent children/spouses.
2. **RECIPIENT/S MUST BE ENROLLED AS A FULL-TIME STUDENT IN A REGIS UNIVERSITY UNDERGRADUATE OR GRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAM** (students enrolled in certificate programs are not eligible for this scholarship).
3. **PREFERENCE SHALL BE GIVEN TO VETERAN APPLICANTS WHO:**
  - a. Exhibit a lack of resources to meet basic survival needs (food, shelter, etc).
  - b. Can exhibit, by virtue of current FAFSA on file with the Regis Financial Aid Office, a demonstrated need.
  - c. Demonstrate substantive financial hardship due to University decisions such as course cancellations resulting in additional travel expenses in order to access a ground-based class.  
*NOTE: Decisions of this nature will be based on the amount of credit hours the student is taking, impact of University decisions on the GI Bill monthly housing allowance that a student receives, and whether the student must take only online courses due to University decision.*
  - d. **REQUIRED: Include a copy of DD Form 214 or Certificate of Eligibility (COE) reflecting an Honorable Discharge.**  
*NOTE: Students with a General Discharge may apply, and must submit with their application a letter explaining the circumstances which led to the general discharge. Students with a Bad Conduct or Dishonorable Discharge may not apply.*
  - e. Provide brief narrative responses that addresses the following considerations (see pp. 2 – 3):
    1. What are your educational and professional goals?
    2. What are your specific plans for these funds, if awarded?
    3. Why have you selected Regis University for your college education?
    4. Articulate ways in which your financial need inhibits your ability to advance in your education.
  - f. Preference in selecting recipient/s is given to recipient/s based on satisfactory academic standing (at least 12 completed college credit hours at a regionally accredited institution while maintaining a 2.500 grade point average or higher).
4. Recipient/s are selected based on financial need.
5. The scholarship is not automatically renewable; however, eligible students may reapply for a second scholarship one year after completion of the semester in which the initial scholarship was awarded.
6. The recipient/s will be selected by the Military Scholars Fund Selection Committee in consultation with the VA Benefits Coordinator and Certifying Official.
7. Family members of current Regis University employees are not eligible for the Military Scholars Fund.
8. Recipients are strongly encouraged to volunteer 10 hours for the Regis Center for the Study of War Experience or the Regis Military & Veterans Service Center within one year of receiving funding from the Military Scholars Fund.
